Dear Parents, Guardians and Students currently enrolled in Option 2: Teacher Supported Online Learning,

Earlier in February, Parkland School Division requested that you complete your child's registration for the 2021-2022 school year. Recognizing that public health measures will continue to drive many of the decisions for parents and educators alike, we had asked to hear from you in advance when it comes to plans for your child in the next school year. We thank you for completing this process.

After reviewing survey data from our Option 2 French Immersion families, it became apparent that the vast majority of Option 2 French Immersion families intend on returning to in person learning for the upcoming school year. With this in mind, in addition to French Immersion being a Program of Choice, Parkland School Division will not be able to offer our French Immersion through Virtual Learning for the 2021-2022 school year. Those families currently in Option 2 from Ecole Meridian Heights or Ecole Broxton Park School, who wish to continue with an athome online program similar to this year, are encouraged to register for school at Connections for Learning in the English Virtual Learning program. Ecole Meridian Heights and Ecole Broxton Park school will not be providing an Option 2 or at home learning for French Immersion students. We are excited to welcome back all of our online learners to in person learning for the 2021-2022 school year.

If your family is choosing to stay learning from home next year, Parkland School Division is pleased to offer an English <u>Virtual Learning</u> option for families in the upcoming school year. Launched in September 2020, Virtual Learning is a teacher-directed program, supported by the staff from Connections for Learning, that allows students to work full-time from home using virtual learning tools and remote access to content. The Virtual Learning program will be the option for families choosing to remain at home while still accessing school-division support. It is a full-time program, requiring a full-year commitment. Please note, there will be no multiple set re-entry dates to return to in-class delivery. Those that may wish to return to a school in the middle of a school year will follow the process outlined in <u>Administrative Procedure 304:</u>
<u>Attendance Areas</u> with respect to registration and placement and Parkland School Division's <u>School-of-Choice</u> process.
