This report summarizes the results achieved by École Broxton Park School's grade six and grade nine students for the June 2019 Provincial Achievement Test period.

Assessment for Learning

School administration and staff carefully analyze the results of the June 2019 Provincial Achievement Tests to guide classroom instruction moving forward.

With respect to Provincial Achievement Tests:

The School surpassed the Province of Alberta's results on:

- 3 of 10 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Acceptable Standard; and
- 2 of 10 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Standard of Excellence.

The School surpassed Parkland School Division's results on:

- 5 of 10 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Acceptable Standard; and
- 6 of 10 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Standard of Excellence.

The School results surpassed last year's results on:

- 6 of 10 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Acceptable Standard, and
- 8 of 10 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Standard of Excellence.

The Chart on the next page provides detailed areas of growth and results for our school in comparison to the provincial and school division results.

École Broxton Park School is a unique tri-track school, that consists of three unique program choices for our parents and students. We are the site school for French Immersion programming in Spruce Grove and area. École Broxton Park School hosts five Early Education classrooms with ten classes being served. École Broxton Park School is also the congregated site for Parkland School Division's program for students with significant delays, complex needs and medical fragility, Relating Everyday Academics and Life-skills (REAL) Program. Our Provincial Achievement Test results reflect the results of our students enrolled in the French Immersion program as all other students do not write Provincial Achievement Tests.

Our areas for success and celebration look to our school results with 6 out of 10 tests exceeding the results from last year, as well as 8 out of 10 tests exceeding our Standard of Excellence from last year. We continue to work towards increasing our students' achievement in comparison to the Province of Alberta. This work will continue through Professional Learning Communities and further analysis of the achievement test results to inform our practice and pedagogy.
