**Movies and tv shows being shown at lunch hour** This is a time when students should be engaged in conversations with their peers and teacher



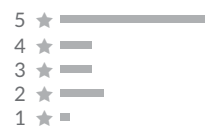

**We honestly really love the school** I have opinions but overall we are really very happy with Broxton and we love listening to our littles speaking French and learning so well



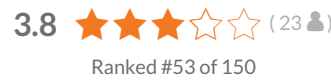

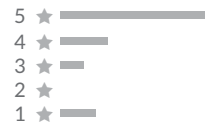
**Appreciate - Programs offered** Our child is an active soul. He enjoys sports as well as the arts. At Broxton - BOTH are offered and encouraged.



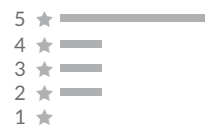
**Communication** We have been extremely happy with the amount of communication received both from teachers and office staff.
