



**Administration Report for School Council
École Broxton Park School
May 17, 2023.**

- Registration for Next School Year
 - 625 students currently registered for the French Immersion program
 - 30 students registered for the REAL program
 - Early Education will have 3 sections (student enrollment count not determined at this time)
- New Principal for Ecole Broxton Park School 2023-2024

- Gr. 9 Quebec Trip - What a success! Trip went very smoothly and the students thoroughly enjoyed the trip. Now we are working on our promo video with updated photos before calling a parent info night for the 2024 ÉBPS & ÉMHS Quebec Trip.
- DELF - All grade 8 students completed their international French proficiency exam at the end of April. Many students came out of the exam quite confident that they did well which is a great sign. We should be receiving the results sometime at the end of June. Printed certificates will be either handed to the students or mailed out to students depending on when we receive them.
- French Immersion student delegation attended a PSD School Board meeting on April 11th. Our selected students represented Broxton Park School very well and we appreciate their participation.
- Spring Concerts organized by Mme. Iampen and Mme. Brophy was great. Many parents were in the crowds throughout the afternoon or evening performances. All the students performed really well.
- Today was the first of a few sessions for our Indigenous Education Holistic Learning Framework working committee. We discussed how ÉBPS can not only continue to celebrate Indigenous culture through key dates or events but also how we can better incorporate it through our daily learning activities. For example, in many Indigenous communities, certain styles of teaching and learning are used more frequently such as storytelling, connecting to real-life experiences, and experiential learning or land-based learning. The intent of this work is to set a standard or foundation for all learners,



students, teaching staff, and community to have a starting point in taking the right steps forward. More work to come from this. Also, we are in the process of organizing our celebrations for Indigenous Cultural month. More details to come.

- First two grade 6 and 9 PAT written parts have been completed this week. The vast majority of students chose to write using Chromebooks and all went well with this process. With that being said, we are beginning the process of End of Year assessments in all grade levels. Early years have Alberta Ed assessments to complete while the older grades have typical literacy and numeracy assessments that we have been doing for the past few years.
- Our teaching staff in grades K-6 have and will continue to be involved in various divisional professional development opportunities for new curriculum implementation. K-3 has been already working with the new Math and English Languages Arts and Literature (only grade 3) this year. Next year, K-3 will be adding French Language Arts and Literature and Science while 4-6 will be beginning with ELAL and Math. Social studies has not been confirmed about a start date however we presume September 2024.
- The Fee Schedule for the 2023-2024 school year will only have one change at this point.
 - Cultural Fee will be increased from \$10/per student to \$15/per student due to additional cultural events occurring throughout the school year.
