

PARKING

Please do NOT park at the church across the street; we no longer have permission to use their parking lot for overflow parking. Also, please do NOT park in the nearby business lots. Tickets may be issued by bylaw.

So where ARE parents supposed to park? There is limited parking available to parents and visitors in the parking lot located southeast end of the lot facing the fence. Please respect areas that are designated for staff parking only, and avoid "creating" new parking stalls. We STRONGLY encourage all of our families to utilize the student drop-off lane in order to contribute to a smooth drop off experience.



The map pictured above shows you the direction to follow when dropping off or picking up your child. There are three lanes parallel to the school. The **lane closest to the school is for busses only**. It is very important to remember that ALL parents who are doing the same want to do so in a <u>safe and efficient</u> manner. Please be cautious, considerate and courteous to your fellow Fusion families when navigating this busy lane by driving slowly and carefully.

The drop off lane is to the left of the sidewalk—this is the ONLY area where you are permitted to stop your vehicle long enough for your child to embark or disembark your vehicle safely. <u>Parents are NOT permitted to leave a vehicle unattended in this lane</u>. Supervisors will be present within the drop off area. Should you wish to meet your child at their designated door, then you will need to park in the appropriate parking area and walk to meet your child.

The lane between the drop off and parking is meant to be a <u>non-stopping</u> exit lane only, for those leaving the drop-off lane. Parents are not to park in this lane.

When exiting onto McLeod Ave, we ask that you **turn right** onto McLeod to allow for smoother flow of traffic.

Please proceed with caution when you are driving through the parking lot, driving slowly enough so you are able to stop if you suddenly need to. Parents must yield to busses, busses have priority to ensure their routes are on time.

Thank you to all of our families for both their patience and diligence in adhering to these guidelines in order to ensure the safety of all students, staff, and visitors. We appreciate that parking at Broxton Park School can be challenging, but we know that when it comes to the parking lot, the children's safety is everyone's number one priority!
