4. ÉBPS administrators report:

a. Facilities and Renovations

- Summer Renovations Complete: The back pavement was entirely redone.
- ii. Outdoor Space: Planters were installed with space allocated for an indigenous garden. Fencing and the gate are complete.
- iii. Next Steps (Pending Funds): The basketball court project requires securing additional funding.
- iv. Outdoor Classroom: Seating is currently on order and on its way.

b. School Events and Clubs

- i. Cross Country Running: 120 runners participated.
- ii. Volleyball: The season is currently in full swing.
- iii. Clubs: A Dungeons and Dragons club is already operating.
- iv. Orange Shirt Day/National Day for Truth and Reconciliation:
 - 1. Recognition will be held on September 26th (no classes on the 30th).
 - 2. Resources and activities have been shared with staff for use in classrooms.
 - 3. Breakfast Club is featuring bannock all week, made by a different staff member each day.

c. Feedback and Operational Adjustments

- i. Meet the Teacher: A scavenger hunt helped ensure important parent information was shared.
- ii. Recess Changes: Office referrals related to recess and conflicts during eating time have seen a big reduction.
- iii. Junior High Schedule Adjustment:
 - 1. Issue: Previous schedule had too many unstructured blocks (Flex, library, FLA+), leading to chatting, tech use, or students leaving.
 - 2. Change: Extra work blocks for Math and Science were added for supported practice/work completion.
 - Other Changes: Double blocks for Science labs were added, DLR was integrated into the schedule, and FLA+ was reduced to one block.

d. New Off Grounds Policy (Grades 7 & 8):

- i. Current Status: No off-grounds privileges for Grades 7 and 8 students.
- ii. Reasoning: Concerns related to student safety (wandering, exposure to drugs, fights) in areas like "hamburger hill" and the arena.
- iii. Review: The policy will be re-evaluated in January.
- iv. Exception: Students who live within walking distance and whose parents request they walk home for lunch will continue to be handled case-by-case.

e. Curriculum and Legislative Updates

- i. Curriculum Implementation:
 - 1. New curriculum has been implemented across K-6 for various subjects.
 - 2. Piloting of some subjects has begun for Grades 7-9. (Example: Grade 8 Math is impacted).
- ii. New Ministerial Orders/Acts:
 - 1. Literary materials (September 8th).
 - 2. Education Amendment Act requires parent opt-in (September 1st).
 - Fairness and Safety in Sport Act (September 1st).

f. Parent Teacher Interviews (PTI) and Engagement

- i. PTI Change: Moving to flexible scheduling with the teacher within a time span (to be more responsive, given the single June report card).
- ii. Action for Council: Would the School Council like to schedule a PTI event for November 19th or 20th to align with the book fair evenings?
